Changes to Bus Services – September 2018

Service

WYRE & FYLDE SERVICES

From **1 September 2018** Blackpool Transport will make the following revisions:

1 Fleetwood – Cleveleys – Blackpool – Starr Gate (BLA leaflet)

Timetable revised, adjusting the daily evening service during Illuminations to finish at 1830. Tram service continues as normal to maintain transport links.

3 Cleveleys Park – Cleveleys – Blackpool – Mereside (BLA leaflet)

Timetable revised, adjusting Friday & Saturday evening service during Illuminations. Saturday daytime service revised to operate every half hour during Illuminations.

4 Cleveleys – Blackpool – Mereside (BLA leaflet)

Timetable revised, adjusting Friday & Saturday evening service during Illuminations. Saturday daytime service revised to operate every half hour during Illuminations.

7 Cleveleys – Blackpool – St. Annes – Lytham (BLA leaflet)

Timetable revised, adjusting Friday & Saturday evening service during Illuminations to split in Blackpool Town Centre, affecting cross town links.

9 Cleveleys – Blackpool (BLA leaflet)

Timetable revised, adjusting Saturday daytime service to operate every fifteen minutes during Illuminations.

11 Blackpool – St. Annes – Lytham (BLA leaflet)

Timetable revised, adjusting Friday & Saturday evening service during Illuminations to terminate at New Bonny Street. Saturday daytime service revised to operate every twenty minutes during Illuminations.

17 Blackpool – St. Annes (BLA leaflet)

Timetable revised, adjusting Friday & Saturday evening service during Illuminations to terminate at New Bonny Street. Saturday daytime service times revised during Illuminations.

RIBBLE VALLEY SERVICES

From **3 September 2018** Lancashire County Council will make the following revisions:

64 Burnley – Padiham – Clitheroe (LCC Leaflet 3)

Timetable revised, adjusting the following Monday to Friday journeys:

1608 journey from Clitheroe to Burnley to depart at 1603 and operate 5 minutes earlier to Sabden, additionally serving Fence. On schooldays this

journey will commence from Clitheroe Royal Grammar School at 1558;

1708 journey from Clitheroe to Burnley to depart at 1718 and operate 10 minutes later throughout;

1715 journey from Burnley to Clitheroe to depart at 1720 and operate 5 minutes later throughout;

1815 journey from Burnley to Clitheroe to depart at 1820 and operate 5 minutes later throughout.

65 Burnley – Padiham – Nelson (LCC Leaflet 3)

Timetable revised, adjusting the 0710 Monday to Friday journey from Nelson to Padiham to depart at 0705 and operate 5 minutes earlier throughout.

66/67 Clitheroe – Barley – Nelson (LCC Leaflet 3)

Timetable revised, adjusting the following Monday to Friday morning peak journeys at the request of regular customers:

0607 Service 67 journey between Clitheroe and Nelson will be revised with some timing points departing up to 4 minutes earlier;

0752 Service 66 journey between Fence and Clitheroe will be revised to depart at 0747 and operate 5 minutes earlier throughout. On schooldays this journey will extend to Clitheroe Royal Grammar School.

PRESTON SERVICES

From **3 September 2018** Rotala Preston Bus will make the following revisions:

6/6A Preston – Brookfield – Redscar (PBT leaflet)

Timetable revised, adjusting general times to improve service reliability. Sunday evening timetable revised to operate hourly.

8 Preston – Ribbleton – Moor Nook (PBT leaflet)

Timetable revised, adjusting general times to improve service reliability. Sunday evening timetable revised to operate hourly.

14 Preston – Holme Slack (PBT leaflet)

Route and timetable revised, adjusting the service to terminate at Holme Slack terminus, withdrawing the service along Ronaldsway, Cromwell Road and through to Longsands. Service will be revised to operate half hourly Monday to Saturday daytime.

Lancashire County Council is exploring if alternative solutions can be found to provide a replacement service for those areas affected.

16 Preston – Faringdon Park (PBT leaflet)

Timetable revised, adjusting general times to improve service reliability. Sunday evening timetable revised to operate hourly.

Changes to Bus Services – September 2018

Service

19 Preston – Royal Preston Hospital (PBT leaflet)

Timetable revised, adjusting general times to improve service reliability. The last daily departures revised to 2208 from Preston and 2227 from Royal Preston Hospital.

23 Preston – Royal Preston Hospital – Fulwood Asda (PBT leaflet)

Timetable revised, adjusting general times to improve service reliability. The Monday to Friday daytime frequency increased to operate every 8 minutes.

31 Preston – Savick – Lea (PBT leaflet)

Route and timetable revised, extending through to Lea to replace withdrawn Service 89 journeys from this area. General times revised to improve service reliability.

35 Preston – Tanterton (PBT leaflet)

Timetable revised, adjusting general times to improve service reliability. The Friday & Saturday night journeys to commence from Fishergate Boots operating via Fishergate, Corporation Street and Ringway onto normal route from Friargate.

44 Preston – Ingol – Cottam (PBT leaflet)

Route and timetable revised, extending a clock-wise loop from Cottam via the housing developments on Hoyles Lane. General times revised to improve service reliability.

88 Royal Preston Hospital – Larches (PBT leaflet)

Route and timetable revised, extending the service to additionally serve Savick. General times revised to improve service reliability.

89 Preston – Larches (PBT leaflet)

Route and timetable revised, adjusting the service to terminate at Larches terminus, withdrawing the service through to Lea. Lea will continue to be served with the extension to Service 31.

Service 4C journeys revised to operate hourly, on Preston Colledays only, opposite Service 4 to maintain an half hourly combined service between Preston and Royal Preston Hospital.

**59 Preston – Mellor Brook –
Blackburn
(STG leaflet)**

Route and timetable revised, diverting a number of Monday to Friday peak journeys to serve Mellor Brook BAe Main Entrance.

**61 Preston – Kirkham – Blackpool
(STG leaflet)**

Timetable revised, adjusting journey times to address delays experienced around the anti-fracking site at Plumpton.

**68 Preston –
Lytham St. Annes – Blackpool
(STG leaflet)**

Timetable revised, adjusting the 1655 college days only journey from Preston College to depart at 1640 and operate 15 minutes earlier throughout.

Timetable revised, restoring the normal Monday to Saturday frequency following the summer school holidays. Service 125C journey from Charnock Richard to Preston College will extend and terminate at Myerscough College.

CHORLEY SERVICES

**6/6A Chorley – Lower Burgh –
Coppull Circular**

7C Chorley – Weld Bank Circular

From **3 September 2018** these Chorley Borough Council funded services will be withdrawn and be partially replaced with new Service 357. The section around Coppull will no longer be served but most areas are within access of Arriva's regular daily Service 362 operating between Chorley, Coppull and Wigan.

Changes to Bus Services – September 2018

Service

357 Chorley – Lower Burgh – Tesco (LCC Leaflet 14)

From **3 September 2018** Lancashire County Council in partnership with Chorley Borough Council will introduce this new service, partially replacing the withdrawn Services 6, 6A & 7C.

The new service will operate from CHORLEY Interchange via Clifford Street, Clifford Street (A6), Union Street, St.Thomas' Road, Devonshire Road, Carrington Road, Walgarth Drive, Collingwood Road, Tootell Street, Weldbank Lane, Pall Mall, Harrison Road, Pilling Lane, Carr Lane, Lighthurst Lane, Kirkstall Road, Melrose Way, Carr Lane, Bolton Road, Myles Standish Way, Lower Burgh Way, turn on roundabout junction with Burgh Hall Road, Lower Burgh Way, Yarrow Valley Road, Ackhurst Road, Foxhole Road, Southport Road and internal road to CHORLEY Tesco.

Returning from CHORLEY Tesco via internal road, Southport Road, Foxhole Road, Ackhurst Road, Yarrow Valley Way then outward route reversed to CHORLEY Clifford Street then Chapel Street to CHORLEY Interchange.

Service 357 will run generally hourly Monday to Saturday daytime in conjunction with existing Services 337/347 from Chorley through to Ormskirk/Southport to provide a coordinated service through the joint sections of route.

RS Tyrers will operate this service on behalf of Lancashire County Council in partnership with Chorley Borough Council.

Service

24 Chorley – Brinscall – Abbey Village – Ewood – Blackburn (Transdev Leaflet)

From **3 September 2018** The Blackburn Bus Company will reintroduce this service following customer feedback, splitting the route through to Chorley from Service 4. This new Service 24 will operate every hour Monday to Saturday daytime.

24A Chorley – Brinscall – Abbey Village – Blackburn (Transdev Leaflet)

From **2 September 2018** with The Blackburn Bus Company reintroducing their Monday to Saturday Service 24, Lancashire County Council will revise the Monday to Saturday evening and Sunday Service 4A journeys to again operate as Service 24A to maintain the link with the daytime commercial service operated. There will be no changes to route or timetable of these journeys and they will continue to be operated by Stagecoach in Lancashire on behalf of Chorley Borough Council and Lancashire County Council.

HYNDBURN SERVICES

14/15 Accrington – Great Harwood – Whalley – Clitheroe (BTL leaflet)

From **3 September 2018** Boomerang Travel will withdraw most journeys on this service, with the exception of schoolday only journeys serving Clitheroe Schools.

Lancashire County Council is exploring if alternative solutions can be found to provide a replacement service for those areas affected.

ROSSENDALE SERVICES

From **3 September 2018** Rosso will make the following revisions:

10 Rawtenstall – Edgeside – Rawtenstall (ROS leaflet)

Timetable revised, withdrawing the Monday to Friday journeys at 0738 Rawtenstall – Waterfoot and 0755 Waterfoot – Rawtenstall.

Alternative journeys are available at 0708 & 0725 respectively.

13 Rawtenstall – New Hall Hey – Rawtenstall (ROS leaflet)

Timetable revised, adjusting the Monday to Friday 1555 journey from Rawtenstall to depart at 1550 and operate up to 5 minutes earlier throughout.

446/447 Rochdale – Whitworth – Wallbank (ROS leaflet)

Timetable revised, adjusting the Monday to Friday peak time journeys as follows:

0830 Wallbank to Rochdale retimed to 0840 and operate 10 minutes later throughout;

1449 Rochdale to Bacup terminated at Wallbank with the section through to Bacup replaced with an additional Service 464 journey.

464 Accrington – Rawtenstall – Bacup – Rochdale (ROS leaflet)

Timetable revised, adjusting journey times for the commencement of the new school year.

465 Rawtenstall – Bacup – Todmorden (ROS leaflet)

Timetable revised, adjusting the Monday to Friday 1526 journey from Rawtenstall to Todmorden to depart at 1522 and operate up to 4 minutes earlier throughout.

481 Blackburn – Haslingden – Rawtenstall – Edenfield – Bury (ROS leaflet)

Timetable revised, adjusting the Monday to Friday journey times to improve overall service reliability.

482 Bacup – Rawtenstall – Edenfield – Bury (ROS leaflet)

Timetable revised, adjusting the Monday to Friday journey times to improve overall service reliability.

483 Burnley – Water – Rawtenstall – Edenfield – Bury (ROS leaflet)

Timetable revised, adjusting the Monday to Friday journey times to improve overall service reliability.
