WYRE SERVICES

Service 1 Fleetwood – Cleveleys – Blackpool – Starr Gate (Blackpool Transport Leaflet)

From **24 June 2018** Blackpool Transport Services will revise the timetable, increasing the general Monday to Friday daytime frequency to every 20 minutes and introduce additional journey time for the summer season.

Service 7 Cleveleys – Blackpool – St. Annes – Lytham (Blackpool Transport Leaflet)

From **24 June 2018** Blackpool Transport Services will revise the timetable, increasing the general Monday to Friday daytime frequency to every 15 minutes.

Service 14 Fleetwood – Thornton – Blackpool (Blackpool Transport Leaflet)

From **24 June 2018** Blackpool Transport Services will revise the timetable, increasing the general Monday to Friday daytime frequency to every 10 minutes.

RIBBLE VALLEY SERVICES

Service 65 Burnley – Padiham – Nelson (LCC Leaflet 3)

From **4 June 2018** Lancashire County Council will revise the timetable, adjusting the 0720 Monday to Friday journey from Nelson to Padiham to depart at 0710 and operate 10 minutes earlier throughout.

Service 66/67 Clitheroe – Barley – Nelson (LCC Leaflet 3)

From **4 June 2018** Lancashire County Council will revise the timetable, adjusting the following Monday to Friday morning peak journeys at the request of regular customers:

0617 Service 67 journey between Clitheroe and Nelson will be revised to depart at 0607 and operate 10 minutes earlier throughout;

0735 Service 67 Schoolday journey between Nelson and Clitheroe will be revised to operate on Monday to Friday throughout the year;

0804 Service 67 Schoolday journey between Barley and Clitheroe will be revised to run as Service 66 commencing from Fence at 0752, departing Barley at 0759 and operate 5 minutes earlier throughout.

Service 280/X80 Preston – Clitheroe – Skipton (Preston Bus Leaflet)

From **3 June 2018** Rotala Preston Bus will revise the timetable, adjusting the Monday to Friday times throughout. The Saturday service will be increased to operate a standard hourly timetable.

These are the changes for June 2018 that have been reported to Lancashire County Council by 16 May 2018.
