Potential Planning Development

At the recent meeting of the Parish Council, Mr Brian Walker talked through the proposed plans being submitted to Ribble Valley Council next week by BKW Development Ltd, details of which will be on the noticeboard and parish website after submission. The following images show the site of the proposed development.



The proposal is for the erection of nine blocks for office/ industrial/warehouse use. Access to the site will be from the north on the Blackburn Road. This is a major proposed development and we understand many residents will want to have a chance to put forward their point of view.



In response to residents' comments already received and once the plans have been submitted a public meeting will be held at the Pavilion, Hothersall Lodge on Tuesday 14th March at 7.30pm.

BT Openreach has connected fibre to the cabinet at the top of the Lane but this has not yet been enabled and there are no plans currently to do so.
