

Historians' Christmas Walk: Fradley <u>Aerodrome</u> Friday 30 December <u>2022</u>

Historians were treated to a very interesting walk guided by Member Roger Price around Fradley Aerodrome. There were many traces of WW2

activity and in fact the Royal Air Force Station Lichfield was in use from 1940 to 1958. There were many buildings from that era (one now housing six old pianos!) and pill boxes.





The group also visited the Churchyard at St Stephen's Church, Fradley, where 24 RAF servicemen from the RAF base at Fradley are



commemorated, together with 1 German and 24 Royal Australian Air Force servicemen.
