

Kings Bromley Historians Boundary Walk

In 1984, the historic practice of walking the parish boundary, last carried out in 1894 (but also known to have taken place in 1839), was re-established by Kings Bromley Historians. This was repeated in 1994, 2004 and 2014, and it is intended to do it again on Saturday 21st September this year. As the boundary does not always follow footpaths, we rely on landowners to give us permission to cross their land. The entire walk is about 19 miles, but walkers can choose to do it all, or pick sections. Refreshments will be provided by the Historians at the three stops. The start times from the four sections will be:

8.45 am	Section 1.	Start at Yoxall bridge.
11.00am	Section 2.	Start at Armitage football ground/CHADS.
1.00pm	Section 3.	Start at junction of A515 and Wood End Lane, Lunch
4.00pm	Section 4.	Start at Lupin Farm.

Those who complete the whole walk or any section will receive a certificate to mark their achievement. For every section, the walkers will sign a disclaimer form that they understand that they need to proceed with care across any obstacles and uneven ground, and that they do so entirely at their own risk.

Walkers are invited to 36, Alrewas Road, at 8pm, that evening to celebrate and receive their certificates.
