The Lane family seal

I have been in contact recently with Andrew Lane of Cork who is the great, great grandson of Thomas Lane (1754 to 1824) who, along with his brother John Lane, inherited Kings Bromley from Elizabeth Newton in 1794. Andrew is doing interesting research on his family tree. He has in his possession a Lane seal which he has sent us photos of:





This has the familiar roan horse and 'Garde Le Roy' inscription which we see on many other Lane artifacts:
