Historians visited Wall Roman site on 25 May and thoroughly enjoyed a guided tour of the Roman ruins and a visit to the museum. The guide was excellent, bringing the whole site to life with its 'Mansio' on Watling Street (it was a two-storey hotel, the Roman equivalent of a Travelodge on the A38!) and baths, offering a spa experience to travellers. Wall was an important small town in Roman times, thanks to its vicinity to Watling Street and Ryknild Street. The museum is small, but full of artefacts from the site. This was followed by a very good meal for the whole group at The Trooper pub just down the road.
