Dear Marilyn,


I am writing to thank you for your recent participation in research supporting the draft London Environment Strategy consultation. Over the course of the consultation we have heard from around 3,000 Londoners. It has been wonderful to see the interest and response that the draft strategy has prompted.

The team are now reviewing all responses and will take them into consideration when drafting the final version of the strategy, which will be published in 2018, alongside a report of all the consultation responses. The qualitative research programme which you participated in has been a valuable source of insight for the team. I know that the team appreciated the opportunity to speak to you in depth in this way and get to an understanding of your views on key issues.

There are a number of insights to come out of the work which have struck me, and which will be points of interest as we come to redraft the strategy. Notably the importance of green infrastructure to quality of life in London and the enthusiasm of Londoners to be a part of improving London's environment, whether it be through recycling, energy efficiency or celebrating their local parks.

I hope that you will continue to take an interest in the Mayor's work to improve London's environment and would encourage you to continue to tell us about issues you care about and ideas you have to make London an even better place to live.
