Short summary	Communities from across the borough gathered at Glenmore House in Surbiton on Sunday 26 January to commemorate Holocaust Memorial Day. Speakers included Kingston Faith and Belief Forum chair, Reverend Joe Moffatt, and Rabbi Yechezkel Mandelbaum of the Kingston Orthodox Synagogue, who also performed the Schindler's List Theme and music by Bach on the Accordion. The Children's Cheder Choir, delivered a powerful reading of the poem 'For a Better Future', and Kingston Liberal Synagogue Choir sung 'Ledor Vador' accompanied by the guitar.  2025 also marked the 30 anniversary of the genocide in Bosnia. Guests listened to a testimony from Arnesa Kustura on 'Remembering Srebrenica' and then everyone was invited to participate in a minute of silence and reflection following the lighting of candles, which was accompanied by the prayer 'El Malei Rachamim', sung by Rabbi Lev Taylor of the Kingston Liberal Synagogue.
