### 20/10. Precept 2020/21

The Parish Council agreed to set a precept of £8280. The cost of producing the newsletter, £950 was included and the provision of a new dog waste bin, £300 at Ulting Lane. Reserves were increased by £2000, churchyard fence repairs and work on trees in closed churchyards, with all other expenditure remaining similar to the previous year.

- c) The Parish Council confirmed that it had sufficient funds to carry out the works necessary. (required by the Parochial Church Council)
