21/130. Apologies for absence

21/131. Minutes of previous meetings

21/129. Next meeting – A request to start future Parish Council meetings at 7.30pm had been received from the Village Hall Management Committee. Councillors agreed to the new start time. In addition, the Village Hall Management Committee had asked if their AGM could be held before the next Parish Council meeting. This was also agreed. 20/122. Further to the Clerk's request to extend the double yellow lines near Hoe Mill, double yellow lines along Church Road and in front of Brockley Cottages were discussed. It was agreed that this was not necessary and would contribute to urbanising the rural scene. It was noted that the village bonfire would be held on Sunday 31st October at the Village Hall commencing at 6.30pm.

T1 - Silver Birch - Fell - tree is dead. Ulting Wick, Crouchmans Farm Road, Ulting. Councillors agreed that no comment was required.

RES/MAL/21/00752 - Reserved matters application for the approval of access, appearance, landscaping, layout & scale for the construction of 160 residential units with associated access,

parking, servicing and landscaping (Phase 1 only) on approved application 15/00419/OUT (Part outline/part detailed (hybrid) application for mixed use development including:

- (i) Residential development (Use Class C3) for up to 1138 dwellings including 30% as affordable housing (Outline)
- (ii) Residential Care for up to 120 beds (Use Class C2) (Outline)
- (iii) "Neighbourhood" uses which may include retail, commercial, and community uses (Use Classes A1 and/or A2 and/or A3 and/or A4 and/or A5 and/or D1b) (Outline)
- (iv) Primary school and early years childcare facility (Use Class D1c) (Outline)

Land At Broad Street Green Road And Langford Road And Maypole Road, Great Totham. Councillors agreed that no comment was required.

TCA/MAL/21/00849 - T1 Lime - Reduce in height by 9 metres. T2 Sycamore - Remove. T3 Oak - Remove 3 metres in length from the branch on the north-east side, remove 3 metres in length from the branch on the east side and 5 metres from the branch to the south. T4 Oak - Remove 3 metres in length to 2 x branches on from the south western lower side and 1 x branch back to the man trunk. T5 Oak - Reduce 2 metres from the end of the branch located on the eastern side. The Old Vicarage, Crouchmans Farm Road, Ulting. Councillors agreed that no comment was required.

21/141. Hatfield Road

Councillors discussed the speed limit and road condition of B1019. The clerk had submitted four requests to the Local Highways Panel asking for a reduction in the speed limit for all sections. A response had been received from Cllr. Durham stating that: A review of the ECC Speed Management Strategy was being undertaken and therefore it had been decided that all LHP applications for changes to speed limits would be held until this was finalised. In the past there had been numerous applications, such as these, which have not complied with the necessary criteria. As this may now change, we are keeping many previous cases on the awaiting funding list rather than removing them. Regarding the dangerous pothole and drain cover on Hatfield Road, it was agreed that Cllr. Magness would contact Essex Police.

21/142. Chelmer Valley Landscape Group update.

Cllr. Magness reported that the first workshop would be held on 4th November 2021 at Little Baddow Village Hall. There would be three discussion topics: Managing/facilitating public engagement, Conservation management and enhancement of the natural and historical environment and Cultural significance of the valley's landscape.
