The Parish Council is a corporate body and of the framework of local democracy and represents the interests of the community on various levels.

To be eligible to stand as a Parish Councillor you must be:

- (i) over 18 years old
- (ii) are registered on the electoral register, live or have had your place of work in the Parish for 12 months or more or
- (iii) live within 3 miles of the Parish.

The position of Parish Councillor is unpaid, but you can claim some expenses.
