Laindon Common Conservation

Our local Common is managed on behalf of Basildon Council by the Laindon Common Conservators, who are currently trying to restore part of the Common to lowland heath. Lowland heath is a rare



habitat in this part of the country and with its restoration they hope to bring back some of the flora and fauna which previously existed here. A recent survey has recorded 81 species of birds on or adjacent to the boundaries of the Common together with sightings of 123 different moths including the rare 'Waved Black'. This is only the beginning of the project...

With the help of the local farmer they have already cleared the pond on the main drive and cut and cleared a footpath from the Dukes Head to the main car park. If you are interested in helping please call John Ellis Chairman of the Laindon Common Conservators on 01277 657 100.
