The **June Club Workshop**, held on 24<sup>th</sup> was very well attended. Tim opened up the meeting with a discussion on competitions. He raised questions that are well worth taking time to think about and discuss.

Why do we enter competitions?

Do we like entering them?

What holds us back from entering?

He ran through the benefits for us as individuals and the club itself. For me, one of the most tangible reasons to enter prints is that I spend far more time actually looking at them compared to a PDI on the computer screen. As a result, I see far more detail that I might otherwise not have noticed. Tim also mentioned some different options for producing and mounting prints – a topic we will return too and we would welcome your ideas on. The rest of the meeting was spent looking at two of the 2023-4 seasons competitions – **Reflections** and **Minimalism**. Tim looked at possible definitions for these terms and showed some examples ranging from the simple, to more complex ideas and even examples that would take us further than that. Tim also introduced us to some different photographic techniques, we might or might not be aware of – The Brenizer Method, The Adamski Effect and finally Focus Stacking.
