# Field Trip: Wivenhoe Woods - Fungi

Sunday 08 October 2023 10:30 to 14:30

Wivenhoe Woods covers the largest area of the Colne Local Nature Reserve and is found at the central and southern end. The main woodland tree species are Sweet Chestnut although there are a total of 16 tree species on the site including Oak, Field Maple and a number of small Elms. Also discover the fascinating range of mushrooms and toadstools that grow here.

M&DPS are meeting in the small car park at the end of Rosabelle Avenue (CO7 9PA)
