Photography Marathon 2024 Rules

1. Start & finish location: Mistley Village Hall Shrubland Road Mistley CO11 1HS

2. There is a £5 entry charge.

3. The Photography Marathon is an entirely digital event so you can take part with a digital camera or mobile phone. You must provide your own memory card, which must be empty of images at the beginning of the day.

4. You will be asked to capture ten images, one for each of the subjects given to you. You are not permitted to have more than ten images on your card at the time of submission, but you may have less. You can delete images on the memory card prior to submission. All ten images must be different – you must not use the same image twice.

5. You must collect the topics at the start, in person, from Mistley Village Hall.

6. All images must be taken on 22nd June 2024 between 10 am and 3 pm.

7. All images must be shot as JPEG's – RAW images will not be accepted.

8. You can use tripods, flashguns and filters.

9. You are not permitted to edit the images "off camera".

10. You are permitted to use "in-camera" effects such as black & white or other tools that are camera based.

11. You are not permitted to amend the filename or any other data related to the images.

12. Any manipulation (or suspected manipulation) of the image or its metadata will cause the entry to be disqualified. This decision will be at the discretion of the organisers of the event and is final.

13. To qualify for final judging, your memory card must be returned by 3 pm on the day of the event. Good luck!
