On 12 April 2020 Bishop Stephen Cottrell left his role of Bishop of Chelmsford after nearly a decade in post. Later this year he will become the Archbishop of York. ## MARGARETTING PARISH COUNCIL - UPDATE

### PARISH ASSEMBLY

In line with government guidelines the parish council will not be convening the May 2020 Parish Assembly. It is hoped at some later date the chairman's annual report will be published to read online.

### THE BLACK BULL

The chairman has received confirmation from Chelmsford City Council that The Black Bull has been listed as a community asset.

A restriction will be registered against the owner's registered title of the Listed Asset at the Land Registry which states: "No transfer or lease is to be registered without a certificate signed by a conveyancer that the transfer or lease did not contravene section 95(1) of the Localism Act 2011".

Chelmsford City Council's report concluded:

"Therefore, the use of the property furthers the social wellbeing or interests of the local community. .... The pub seems to play a central role in the local community and brings people together for good causes.

It is realistic to think that there can continue to be non-ancillary use of the building or other land which will further (whether or not in the same way) the social wellbeing or social interests of the local community.

The Parish Council would like to see the continued use of the building for the community, so it is likely that they will ensure as far as possible, a continued community use. The building has been used as a pub for many, many years, and continues to thrive. It is realistic to think that this use will continue (save for current restrictions due to Covid-19)."

## CORONAVIRUS CRISIS SCAMS

There are currently numerous phone calls, bogus emails and text messages circulating, appearing to come from official bodies, such as Local and National Government, World Health Organisation and Centres for Disease Control.

They contain links which are designed to download malicious software to your device, or to take you to a website that will collect your personal and financial details. There are a variety of forms these emails can take.

These can include:

- offering a tax rebate
- changing council tax bandings
- demanding payment of a fine
- asking for donations
- linking to a map of the spread of coronavirus

The advice remains the same. If an email is unexpected, you should not click on any links, but simply delete the email.

You should use the **ABC** approach:

- never Assume they are legitimate
- never Believe they are legitimate
- always Confirm using a trusted number or asking friends and family

There are a number of genuine council schemes operating at the moment which are genuine, such as the Essex Welfare Service – these callers will have no issue with you verifying who they
