Please name the files so they are the title of the photograph. Ideally images should be no wider than 1600 pixels and no taller than 1200 pixels (but don't worry if they're not).

Competitions usually have 3 sections: Nature, a set Theme and Open. Members can enter up to 4 images spread across the 3 sections. All elements of an image should be the work of the author. Nature images should not include pets, domesticated animals or cultivated plants. Only limited manipulation is allowed in Nature section.

It is assumed that winning images may be used on the club's website unless the member indicates otherwise and that any entries may be used by the club in inter-club competitions.
