
















NHS 75 1948 - 2023

We're asking you to help us Make Space for Girls by going to the park and do one simple thing – count. We need to know who is using the MUGAs, skate parks and BMX tracks in your area.

By doing a very brief observation and spot count, you will give us valuable information on how well parks cater for teenage girls – data which we currently don't have. It will take a just a few minutes and make a big difference.

Your results will help us put together a national picture of who uses teenage facilities and whether they work for girls. We will use this data to draw attention to the issue and to persuade councils, developers and other bodies that they need to design with teenage girls in mind.
