Covid-19 vaccinations for children aged 6 months to 4 years

If your child is aged six months to four years, they may be eligible for a Covid-19 vaccination if they have a medical condition including:



Severe breathing conditions including Cystic Fibrosis & poorly controlled asthma



Significant heart diseases such as cardiomyopathy



Chronic kidney, liver or digestive problems



Neurological problems including Cerebral Palsy, autism, muscular dystrophy, Down's Syndrome & those on the learning disability register



Diabetes



Immunosuppressed patients - those with certain cancers, leukaemia, organ/ bone marrow or stem cell transplant recipients and auto-immune disorders



Sickle cell & thalassaemia



Vision Zero is our ambition to eliminate deaths and serious injuries on Essex roads by 2040.


Whilst considerable success has been made in recent years, there were still 49 deaths and 769 serious injuries recorded in Essex during 2022.



Colchester's traditional Remembrance Service and wreath-laying ceremony will be held at the War Memorial on Colchester High Street, beginning at 10.45am on Sunday, 12 November.

Soldiers from the town's 16 Air Assault
Brigade will be on parade, alongside civic
dignitaries including the Mayor of Colchester,
Cllr John Jowers, and HM Lord-Lieutenant of
Essex Mrs Jennifer Tolhurst.

A 105mm Light Gun from 7th Parachute Regiment Royal Horse Artillery will fire, to mark the beginning and end of the two-minute silence at 11am.
