Depending on which 'communal aerials' you are referring to, if it is the TV communal aerial then there are no plans to upgrade this.

There are a couple of initiatives being looked at by the City:

- Install aerials to provide a wireless concessions to improve wireless coverage across the City – Steven Bage - Strategic Infrastructure Advisor, City Surveyor
  
- Install Fibre cable either to the block or to the home for television and broadband services – Steven Bage - Strategic Infrastructure Advisor, City Surveyor
