It was agreed that the roller should be removed and a “baby swing” purchased in Spring. Rubber stops should also be placed under each end of the see saw.

A66 – Councillor Hutchinson reported that he had not received an e-mail about the plans for improving the junctions on the A66 but was hopeful that this would be soon. He has heard nothing about the need for a tree to be pruned at the Langrigg junction – Councillor Dew said this has been passed to the appropriate people. GREAT MUSGRAVE – The drain near the bus stop has been repaired and is working well.	

	<p>LITTLE MUSGRAVE - Councillor Clarke reported there was no action regarding the signage possibly 2019/20. Bob Dow from Highways has been in contact with the land owners regarding the overhanging trees. The broken manhole cover has now been replaced. The milestone between Musgrave & Soulby is missing.</p> <p>MASCG RESPONSE - The chairman will reply to the letter reaffirming the parish's position.</p> <p>FLITHOLME – Nothing to discuss</p> <p>COLLINSON TRUST – There has been a meeting to discuss the 3 applications from the parish and all 3 have been given a grant of the same amount.</p> <p>ARMISTICE DAY - Sunday 11th November at 3pm, Tea Music and sing along. County Councillor Phil Dew as invited to attend. This will be funded by the parish council. Councillor Hutchinson will give a presentation giving the names and details of the residents of Musgrave who had given their life during the war.</p> <p>DRAINS - Further blocked drain near to entrance of the church – needs to be reported. Also a lot of potholes down Langrigg road and one near Hallgarth.</p>	
10/1118	<p>COUNCILLOR MATTERS Re MASCG Response – This did not seem to answer many of the points raised by the residents. The A685 is not suitable for “camping” and the police should try to enforce this and encourage travellers to park caravans elsewhere. Councillor Dew said that Mark Peroni seemed to take this on board. Councillor Dew has received an e-mail from 2 gypsy spokesmen and he would try to liaise with them. Permits for HGV's to be reviewed and enforced by police on A685. The closure of the A66 at Temple Sowerby has resulted on extra money for the County Council which would be spent on roads. Christian Head care home will remain open for the foreseeable future.</p>
