Cumbria Classic Coaches are currently running a "shopper" bus on a Tuesday only at the moment, but if this is a success then they may look into running another day. The Grand Prix at Brough have put on a bus for the out of area school children who travel to Penrith, but this has been done and financed by parents. The rural wheel's service is also still running.

13/0117	<p>BROADBAND</p> <p>The Chairman and Councillor Hutchinson attended a meeting in Carlisle with Mr Harris from Connect Cumbria and it is much more optimistic that better broadband can be rolled out, but not sure of any timescale at the moment.</p>
