<b>09/0418</b>	<b>ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION</b>  <b>A66</b> - There was 3 major incidents within 3 days of each other on the A66. No feedback from Highways. County Councillor Dew reported that there is a meeting with Highways, Police & CCC to talk about what happens about road diversions when there are major accidents as it causes mayhem on the smaller roads and often or not it is caused by wagons been diverted! County Councillor Dew will mention that average	

	<p>speed cameras on the A66 are the only way forward.</p> <p><b>BROADBAND</b> – Nothing new to report.</p> <p><b>LIGHTS</b> – CALC have sent an e-mail out to all parish councillors to wait until further notice from them and not to sign the contract yet.</p> <p><b>CHURCH FIELD</b> - A sign has been put up on the railings near the bridge from the charity who supported the church field trust with funding. Many thanks to Mike Lea who continues to find funding for this project.</p> <p><b>GREAT MUSGRAVE</b> – Councillor Watson has a blocked drain near his property and asked if this could be reported. There are also some pot holes on the Musgrave to Warcop road which also need reporting. County councillor Dew mentioned he will try and get some road signs for when the A66 is closed due to snow to try and stop people from using impassable roads and getting stuck. Mr Dowson has done a lot of work on the playground and the swing is now fixed.</p> <p><b>LITTLE MUSGRAVE</b> - Councillor Clarke reported that the road has been widened. Bob Dow from Highways e-mailed to see the trees would be cut back, but as yet nothing has happened.</p> <p><b>FLITHOLME</b> – The bridge has been fixed.</p> <p><b>ARMISTICE DAY</b> – The village hall committee have asked if the parish council would donate some money towards the celebrations. Some ideas are an afternoon tea with fancy dress and a supper at night. The parish council agreed to donate an amount.</p> <p><b>GDPR POLICY</b> – The freedom of information act will cease in May and the GDPR will replace this. The clerk has been working on policies ready for this and they will be ready for the next meeting.</p>	<b>HS</b>
