341/2021 BRIDGE STREET CROSSING:

Cllr Buckley was informed the Parish Council had received residents request for a Crossing on Bridge Street because of the cars exceeding the limit. The crossing is widely used by older people and children. Cllr Buckley informed the meeting of a previous scheme requested some years ago by residents, on consultation refused to support the scheme because of the yellow lines proposed along Bridge Street. Cllr Buckley stated the cost of a crossing is in the region of £120k - £170k, a viability study is necessary to ascertain the usage and it is likely a similar proposal would be put forward. It would be an advantage if the Parish Council could carry out a consultation before any proposal is put forward to the Basildon Highways Panel
