

PARISH COUNCIL GRANT PROJECT FUNDING

The Parish Council granted the Noak Bridge Nature Reserve £2,440.00 towards the cost of an ECO Clad Container sited on the Nature Reserve to store tools & equipment used by the volunteers. Noak Bridge Pre School were awarded £500 towards an outdoor learning space project. A grant of £400 was awarded to Noak Bridge Residents Association for start up equipment for the recently installed Petanque Court. Since reducing the overall administration costs this has allowed the Parish Council to invest the savings into the community and their projects.
