#### NOAK BRIDGE PARISH COUNCIL REPLACE GOAL POSTS ON SOUTH WASH ROAD PLAYING FIELD

The Parish Council have recently replaced the worn out goal posts situated on the South Wash Road Playing Field and had the smaller goal posts reinstalled.

Following a request from Noak Bridge Parish Council, Wickford and Crouch County Councillors Tony Ball and Malcolm Buckley made an application for a "20's plenty" speed reduction scheme to the Basildon Local Highways Panel. The proposed area covers Coppice Lane and the area around Noak Bridge Primary



School. The aim of the scheme is to reduce the speed of vehicles in and around schools. If agreed by the Local Highways Panel, a full consultation will be carried out with local residents and the school, including the pupils, who will be asked to create a design for the signage that will be erected in Coppice Lane.
