COMMUNITY PROJECT— PETANQUE

The Parish Council have approved funds to provide a Petanque court. (The French Game of Boules) The court will be sited next to the Village hall making access easy, within walking distance for all residents. The project is to provide a social space for residents to meet socialise and play a very easy, yet interesting game although challenging, which can be played by all adults over 16 of all



abilities. For those unfamiliar with the game it is played on an all weather gravel court, so year round use is possible. Similar to lawn bowls, heavy metal "Boules" are aimed at a small wooden target ball called a cochonnet; up to three Boules are used by players and the player who gets his Boule closest to the "coch" scores the point or points. Work will hopefully start in July with completion by beginning of August. Further details and open day with lessons provided for those unfamiliar with the game.
