- Improving our Environment; primarily this is through the upkeep of the Centenary Garden which we manage on a voluntary basis.
- Sharing Information; We offer talks on local attractions such as the Hogs Back Brewery, but also try to keep villagers up to date with local planning issues which could affect the wider village community such as the proposed building developments nearby and the process and progress of the review of our primary healthcare services currently taking place.

 and also on the NHS Stakeholder Committee for Primary Healthcare. Local
 councillors also have open channels with the committee with respect to
