## ANNUAL REPORT APRIL 2023 TO MARCH 2024

The election of new Officers and appointment of a new Committee at the Annual General meeting on May 2023 marked a turning point in the Hall's history as prior to this there hadn't been an active Committee or regular meetings since before COVID in 2020.

Having an active Committee who work well together has given the Hall stability and enabled things to move forward.

It is now coming up to 24 years since the Hall was built and the building has been in need of some remedial work. During the year in addition to the necessary annual checks etc, improvements have been carried out to internal and external lighting, the contents of the computer room sorted, WiFi installed, PRS licence purchased and the kitchen upgraded with a new cooker and fridge.

Following criminal damage in January when a CCTV camera was broken and the kitchen window smashed, the window was replaced and the purchase of a new upgraded CCTV system agreed to replace the existing old version.

Further work will be required in the forthcoming year< particularly the replacement of the Hall floor.

Mrs Megan Lloyd - the longest serving Officer and only remaining Trustee very sadly passed away on 12th October aged 92 after a short illness. Condolences were sent to her family and her loss marked by the Committee.
