The Member of the public responded to an email from the Chairman that stated "the footpath allowing access to the castle bailey from pump lane had been closed by Mr JJ Tufnell because of a disagreement with Essex County Council." It was noted that closing a footpath is difficult. On review of the private archives there is no mention of any footpath being closed or even discussions on closing a footpath Nor any reference to a footpath between Pump Lane and the Castle.

On review of the minutes from the Annual Parish Meeting of the 19th May 1980 and the Minutes from the Pleshey Parish Council 10th November 1980 there was no mention of a footpath between Pump Lane and the Castle. Both minutes mentioned Mr Tufnell closing the Mount and Moat area to the public. May 1978 a Pleshey Pageant was held by the Pleshey Pageant Committee, In consideration for the use of the Castle, they agreed to a donation to Mr Tufnell of £500 towards historic excavations. The Payment did not occur until June 1981. Mr Tufnell closed the Castle in late April or early May 1980 with a commitment to reopen the castle should the payment be made. Mr Tufnell reopened the Castle from the 4th July 1981. The £500 donation (with a £1000 payment from Mr Tufnell) was used towards the excavations carried out by Stephen Bassett which was carried out in 1981. Chelmsford Museum is currently writing up the unfinished reports from the Bassett digs. There is no evidence that there has ever been a footpath from Pump Lane to bailey or even an assumption of one.
