Tea and coffee will be available at half-time; there will also be a raffle.



ALL SAINTS CHURCH

Good news and bad news! The heating is fixed for now, but really needs replacing. We are in consultation with the diocese about how this proceeds, but it will almost certainly require significant fundraising over the next few months.

To start this off, our first "event" of the year will be a concert at Easter. At the moment we are not sure whether this will be on Easter Sunday or Easter Monday, but this will be confirmed as soon as possible, so keep an eye out on Facebook and the good old fashioned noticeboards in the village.

Lyn is planning one of her wonderful flower arrangements as a memorial for loved ones for the Easter Weekend. Details of how to have someone's name displayed on the list will follow nearer the time.

Following that, on Monday 26th May (Spring Bank Holiday Monday) there will be an open day at the church, with the emphasis on heritage, and we hope to have some old record books from the Essex Record Office on view, as well as the usual refreshments and things for sale. The Humfrey memorial will be 300 years old in 2027, so we are looking forward to more heritage events in the lead up to celebrating that.

Previous meeting minutes and February Agenda items:-Bell Field - Fly-Tipping, etc.

In the September meeting, following residents asking for the Parish council support for the removal of the fly-tipping on the Upper Bell Field, a detailed discussion took place. The Parish Council requested a breakdown of the proceeds from the Trustees of the Bell Field Charities of the funding events which had occurred. One quote for the removal was put forward by the trustees. Councillors requested that the trustees produce a grant application with three quotes, since the funding would be over £1,000, to the Council for consideration.

At the December meeting a resident queried about the fly-tipped material on the Bell Fields and installation of a gate offered by the Trustees of the Bell Fields. The Parish Council have not taken this any further as the remit is under the trustees. The resident was assured the gate restrictions would be put in place by the chairman of the Trustees, Mr. Ride.

Mr. Ride, in his capacity as chairman of the Management Trustees of the Bell Field charities, gave assurances that the Trustees would contribute £2,000 towards the cost of the removal of the fly-tipped material. There was also an application to the Parish council for it to fund the removal of the material, even though only one quote had been obtained. Mr. Ride said it had not been possible to obtain any other quotations.

The January meeting item on the Bell fields indicated the Parish Council chairman had received a letter from the Chairman of the trustees in respect of the offer of the £2,000 from the trustees, which reduced the amount by £900 due to expenses on the fly-tipping already paid out.

The agenda for the February meeting has been put on the notice boards and it is noted:-

Item 156-24/25

- To discuss and agree to the offer from the Chairman of the Trustees of the Bell Fields which reinstates the offer of £2000 towards the fly-tipping, subject to confirmation from the Parish Council that, should it engage Dunmow Group to dispose of the waste and benefit from the £900 credit previously discussed, it will reimburse the charity with the sum credited by Dunmow Group.
- To discuss and agree the next steps in regard to the removal of the fly-tipped material at The Bell Fields
- To confirm arrangements for the weekly and bi-weekly inspections of the play equipment located on The Bell Fields to allow the equipment to be returned to use.

Item 157-24/25 Appointment of Trustees to the Bell Fields Charities

To agree to appoint for a maximum tenure of 4 years commencing February 2025 three additional trustees for registered charity 271479 ("Allotment for the Labouring Poor") and registered charity 271480 ("Allotment for Exercise and Recreation"). Proposed by Cllr Parsad.
