By the time this newsletter goes out a new, co-opted, member of the
 Parish Council will be in place.

Draft March Minutes to be approved at the April Meeting.

Residents have raised concerns about the inferior quality of the
 roadworks on the Estate, following pot-hole filling. The Chairman
 agreed to contact Cllr Sue Dobson, the new Essex County Councillor,
 to find out more. Since then there has been letters stating further
 work is to be undertaken.

Residents have asked if the new Community Bus Service to Wickford
 can include Woodham Ferrers, or another set up to do so. The
 service is fortnightly from Tuesday, 1st April. Discussions with RPC
 will be made to see if future funding will allow the continuation, or
 additional, services.

Sonters Down Play Area - The price for the zip wire has increased
 which had to be agreed by the RPC. A discussion took place about the
 cost and the quotes being shared with all councillors. The increase
 has been agreed.

The fly-tipping on the Bell Fields is awaiting the full report from the
 Trustees to enable it to be shared with other contractors for quotes
 for removal.

It was agreed to pay for play equipment is to have a ROSPA annual
 inspection.

Councillors have agreed to the refurbishment of the pavilion on the
 Bell Fields to bring it back to a usable condition. Further discussions
 will take place regarding the refurbishment programme.

Three further trustees were appointed to the Bell Fields charities.

A grant has been awarded to Hayes Country Park Club House to
 support the entertainment for a celebration event for VE 80th
 Anniversary.

VE day 1945 - Memories

Pat's recollection of VE day 1945

I can't remember how old I was, but we stayed the whole weekend in Birdcage Walk, which, if I remember correctly, was only a little way away from Buckingham Palace. We went to Hyde Park the night before the actual VE day and walked all the way round and saw people sleeping on the pavement and on the grass. Sailors and airmen were sleeping in hammocks slung between trees. It was all quite exciting for a little girl.

Then the next day we were out quite early - oh - and the people, it was unbelievable how many people! I felt very squashed and we watched the King and the Queen and the princesses and Churchill come out on the balcony of the Palace and wave to the crowd.

Also walking through the crowds and the traffic, the buses were so huge. It was all very exciting. I was very lucky. I don't know who we stayed with, and I don't know why we went there, but it was exciting. I stayed with so many people because of my mother and father spitting up, so it must have been through one of them that we stayed there.

"Soldier in the Circus" by Edward Lyme)

The Circus was packed so tightly it seemed possible to take one's feet from the ground and still remain upright. VE day, 8th May 1945, had brought the crowds from all over London and beyond to celebrate the end of six years of war in Europe, and Piccadilly Circus was the focal point. Everywhere the jubilant throng was solid; the thousands in Piccadilly spread along to Leicester Square to become tens of thousands, then down to Trafalgar Square, through the Admiralty Arch, and along the Mall to Buckingham Palace, until there was more than a million people in an unbroken mass from the Circus to the Palace.
