The Rettendon oak has been growing apace this year, and producing quite a number of acorns. The Hall Management Committee are committed to keeping the oak healthy and have, therefore, been in touch with a local tree surgeon. The recommendation is for the tree to get a "hair

cut", but since it has a Tree Preservation Order (TPO) it cannot simply be reduced without authority.

The amount of work is rather extensive due to the size of tree and will probably need a road closure. Obviously this will take time for everything to be in place, but we are letting you know so you can collect some acorns to grow for your own Rettendon Oak.
