



#### To be a Councillor, you need to:

Care about getting the best for your community. Be willing to represent your electorate. Want to make a difference. Undertake training courses. Adhere to the Code of Conduct. Register your business interests. Be committed and enthusiastic.

#### To stand as a Councillor you must be:

- a) A British subject, or a citizen of the Commonwealth or the European Union. And be 18 years of age or over.
- b) Be a local government elector for the council area for which you want to stand.
- c) **OR** have occupied as owner or tenant any land or other premises in the council area during the whole of the 12 months preceding that day;
- d) **OR** had your principal or only place of work in the council area during that same period;
- e) **OR** have resided in the council area during that 12-month period;
- f) You can qualify if you have lived within 4.8km (3 miles) of the council area for 12 months.
