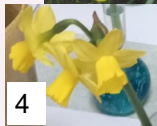
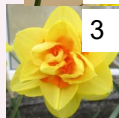
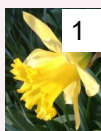
The Spring Show Rose Bowl will be awarded for the most points in Sections H - I

Section A: Daffodils Judge: Thomas Carpenter

- One long trumpet daffodil bloom on one stem (trumpet as long or longer than the petals)
- One short trumpet daffodil bloom on one stem (trumpet shorter than the petals)
- One double daffodil bloom on one stem (double petals)
- Two or more daffodil blooms on one stem
- Three daffodil stems same variety
- Three daffodil stems mixed or matched
- Three stems miniature daffodils
- Three stems daffodils not otherwise named in the schedule



Section E Vegetables Judge: Thomas Carpenter

- Five shoots of sprouting broccoli
- Three sticks of rhubarb trimmed
- Any other vegetable grown in an exhibitor's garden or allotment



Section F Chairman's challenge Judge: Thomas Carpenter

A pot of growing daffodils as from the bulb/ bulbs distributed at last years Autumn Show



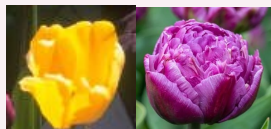
Section G Fun Class Judge: Thomas Carpenter

- One Single bloom
- Three stems Single blooms
- One Double bloom
- Three Stems Double blooms

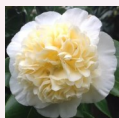
Section C Other Bulbs Judge: Thomas Carpenter

- One or more hyacinths growing in a pot
- Flowering bulbs or corms other than daffodils, tulips and hyacinths growing in a pot



Section D General Flowers and Plants Judge: Thomas Carpenter

- One camellia bloom
- One or more pansies or violas growing in a pot
- One or more polyanthus, primroses or primulas growing in a pot
- A cactus
- A succulent
- An orchid
- A bonsai
- An arrangement of fresh flowers and foliage



Section H Cookery Judge: Katie Sheldrake

- Three individual muffins
- A cake cooked in a loaf tin (state flavour on back of entry card, please)



Section I Photography Judge: Katie Sheldrake

- Sunrise or Sunset
- Signs of Spring



Section J Juniors Judge: Kate Sheldrake

Juniors up to 16 years old on day of show

- A hat or bonnet decorated for Easter by the exhibitor using any materials
- A bulb grown in a pot
- A decorated Stone
