Vacancies

There have been no further applicants for the priest vacancy responsible for the 3 Churches of Buckley, Drury and Ewloe. Some feedback suggests that there is not enough information in the recruitment pack about the area and so we are amending that.

In relation to Llanfynydd, it has been confirmed that there is no additional funding for a priest and so at present the arrangements will remain the same and then in the new year the MAC will be looking at what resources they have and how they can be used most effectively.

Wardens Forum
