



Mission Area Electoral Roll Co-ordinator

The electoral roll of the Mission Area provides information as to the number of people who claim membership of the churches in the Mission Area. The electoral roll provides the names of those who are eligible to be elected onto the Trustee Board (MAC).

The electoral roll is - reviewed each year - destroyed every five years (in years ending with a two or seven), and a new roll begun.

The MA Electoral Roll Co-ordinator will

- Co-ordinate with the churches of the Mission Area to ensure that the annual review of the electoral roll is undertaken
- Co-ordinate with the churches of the Mission Area to ensure that the five-yearly creation of a new electoral roll is undertaken
- Consolidate the electoral rolls of the individual churches into one electoral roll for the Mission Area
- Keep the details of members of the electoral roll in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulations, working with the Data Protection Co-ordinator
- Facilitate the viewing of the electoral roll at a mutually convenient time when requested
- Liaise with the Diocesan Office in the case of a dispute or appeal over the electoral roll.
