On an extremely sad note, Southminster has been the victim of many crimes this month, Please report any crime either online or via 101 or 999. Southminster Parish Council is reporting to the police and working with the Community Protection Officers, however, we have no powers to instruct the police to increase any services. This will happen if everybody reports the crimes.

During March 2020, 5 offenders were caught by the Community Protection Officers speeding through the village, during 5 Tru Cam patrols. No penalty charge notices were issued and 31 vehicles were moved on, when a vehicle is moved on, it means that the allocated five minutes before a notice can be issued has not been met. Disabled drivers displaying a blue badge are permitted to park on double yellow lines for up to three hours.
