High Street Toilets – The toilets will be closed until further notice.

During October 2020, during 6 Trucam patrols, 18 offenders were caught. Four penalty charge notices were issued and 127 vehicles were moved on, when a vehicle is moved on, it means that the allocated five minutes before a notice can be issued has not been met. Disabled drivers displaying a blue badge are permitted to park on double yellow lines for up to three hours.
