## Parish Council Report January 2021

Happy New Year.

Looking ahead to a hopefully more normal 2021, it was agreed at the Parish Council meeting held on 8<sup>th</sup> February 2021, that the Christmas lights would be in the village again for Christmas 2021.

Members also voted to see a return of the fantastic firework display that was held in 2019. This will be provisionally booked in the hope that the event will be allowed to go ahead. Should we still be in restrictions the event will be put on hold until 2022.

King George V Memorial Field – Vandalism has yet again taken place, not only were the individuals breaking lockdown rules they have also caused unnecessary damage and expense to the parish.

The Community Protection Officers have been moving people on from the park who are using the area to walk their dogs. Please be advised dogs are not allowed at King George V Memorial Field.

Please be aware that CCTV is in operation at the King George V Memorial Field, any images obtained regarding antisocial behaviour or vandalism will always be forwarded to the Police and Community Protection Officers.

Thank you to everyone who takes the time to report street lights or other issues around the village.
