Drinking in the Parish

In 1830 a new bell arrived for St Giles' church from Whitechapel. The public had paid for it. To celebrate its arrival before being fitted, it was taken to the Plough Inn where it was filled to the brim with beer for everyone to drink. The festivities lasted till the next morning. The Churchwarden from Berry Farm provided sacks of wheat to secure the bell from falling over.

Local lore from a century ago has it that the last people to be placed in the village stocks were a couple of ladies for indulging too much in the Five Bells pub. The pub used to be at the bottom of Bells Hill near to the current pond in Bells Hill recreations ground.
