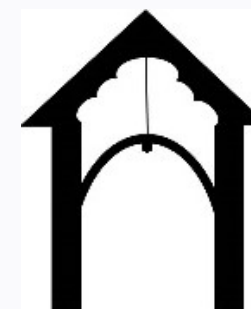

Locked up in the stocks!

In 1830 the managers of the Parish, called the Vestry Committee, ordered stocks and a cage.

The stocks were located at the bottom of Bells Hill. It's recorded that two women were the last to use the stocks for indulging in too much of the old Five Bells pub ale.

The Carry on Dick blockbuster film of 1974 was filmed in and around the Manor House. Film props of stocks were erected in the courtyard. Actor, Kenneth Williams who played a law enforcer, ended up in the stocks, whilst actor, Sid James who played Dick the highwayman and a vicar used the Manor House as his residence and was seen riding in the surrounding countryside.
