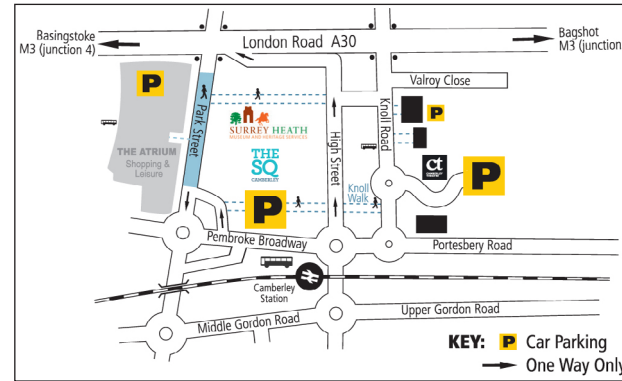
KS2 Bagshot Park and the Tudors

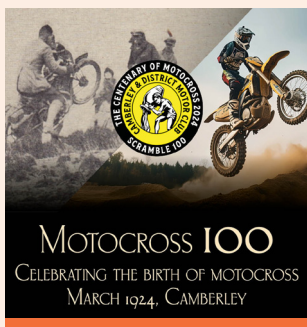
MARCH

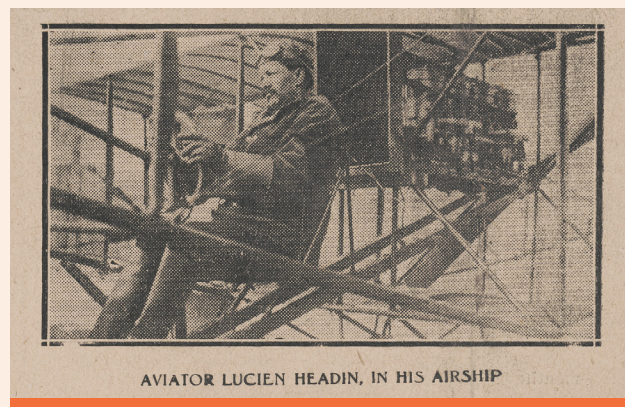
