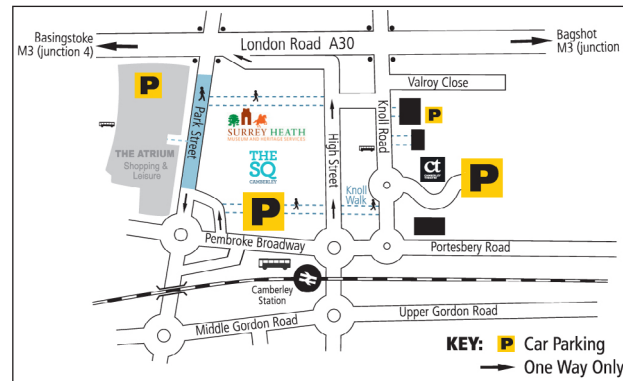

Surrey Heath Museum and Heritage Services manages a museum collection featuring over 30,000 items of social, industrial and archaeology history. They include archives, paintings, costume, domestic items, farming items, photographs and natural history material.

Who we are

Surrey Heath Museum and Gallery is a local heritage partnership in action, creating a heritage hub for the area. Surrey Heath Museum is managed by Surrey Heath Borough Council and has existed since the 1930s. It was originally housed in the local council offices and has a long history of collecting, documenting and promoting the area's heritage. Our partner, Surrey Heath Heritage Foundation, exists to protect and promote the work of Surrey Heath Museum.

Reminiscence service

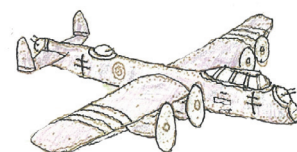
