

# THE RURAL DISTRICT COUNCIL OF GODSTONE.

PRIVATE STREET WORKS ACT, 1892, 55 & 56 Vict., c. 57, s. 6(3).

## Notice of Provisional Apportionment of Expenses of Private Street Works.

To The Owners or Other the Occupiers  
of the land or property upon which  
this notice is affixed

**Take Notice**, that the Rural District Council of Godstone, at their Meeting held on the 30th day of August, 1912, in pursuance of the Private Street Works Act, 1892, by resolution approved of the specifications, plans and sections, estimates and provisional apportionments, prepared by their Surveyor in respect of the parts of Streets known as Emily Road, Louisa Road, and Paynesfield Road, in the Parish of Tatsfield, in the Rural District of Godstone, and that such resolution is in the following terms, viz:—

“That in pursuance of the Private Street Works Act, 1892, the Specifications of the Works proposed to be done in levelling, metalling, channelling and making good the parts of Streets hereinafter described, that is to say—So much of Emily Road as extends for a distance of 334 yards or thereabouts in a northerly direction from its southern termination near the Ship Hotel to its junction with Louisa Road; so much of Louisa Road as extends for a distance of 77 yards or thereabouts in a westerly direction from its junction with Paynesfield Road to its junction with Emily Road; so much of Paynesfield Road as extends for a distance of 346 yards or thereabouts in a northerly direction from its southern termination near the Ship Hotel to its junction with Louisa Road; within the Contributory Place of Tatsfield in the Sanitary District of the Council, and the Plans, Sections, Estimates and Provisional Apportionments relating to such works, now submitted by the Surveyor, be and the same are hereby approved; and that the same be kept deposited for inspection at all reasonable times at the office of Mr. George E. Crowter, Engineer and Surveyor to the Council, Godstone, during a period of one month from the date of the first publication of this resolution.”

**That** you, as owner of the premises situate and known as land on the north west side of the said Paynesfield Road & defined as plot 44 on the late Mr. W. J. Broughton's estate plan which front, adjoin, or abut on Paynesfield Road, herein-before described, are shown as liable to be charged in the provisional apportionments for the sum of nine pounds four shillings, and six pence.

**And That** the approved specifications, plans and sections, estimates and provisional apportionments (or copies thereof certified by the Surveyor) will be kept deposited at the Office of Mr. George E. Crowter, Engineer and Surveyor to the Council, Godstone, and open to inspection at all reasonable times for a period of one month from the Fourth day of October, 1912, during which period you may, in pursuance of section seven of the Act aforesaid, by written notice served on the said Council, object to the proposals on any of the grounds in such section specified.
