- License to erect a seat on the side of Church Hill R.d. at Tatsfield in the County of Surrey. Proposed by Mr Burrows and seconded by Mr Chairman "that this Council do approve of the draft copy of license (or agreement) between the S. C. C. & the Tatsfield Parish Council to erect a seat on the side of Church Hill Road at Tatsfield in the County of Surrey." Carried
- Mrs Wyatt's letter drawing attention to signposts. A letter was read from Mrs Wyatt drawing attention to the misleading sign post at the junction of Cudham R.d. & Ricketts Hill. The Clerk was instructed to write & inform Mrs Wyatt that the County Council had the matter of sign posts under consideration, & that the present direction posts will shortly be replaced by a new design.
