Urban District of Caterham & Clearyham  
have unanimously decided that  
such a transfer would be distinctly  
detrimental to the interest of  
Tatsfield as a whole, and would  
create difficulties in administration  
on the following grounds:-

- (1) The distance between Tatsfield &  
Caterham.
- (2) The difficulty of a representative  
finding an easy means of  
transport or connection to  
Caterham.
- (3) The distinctly Rural character  
istics & interests of Tatsfield  
as compared with Caterham's  
decidedly Urban one.

On these principal grounds
