MINUTES OF THE PARISH MEETING HELD IN THE TATSEL HALL  
CHURCH HALL ON THURSDAY, July 2nd 1964.

Present

Miss Knight in the chair.

40 parishioners 7 Parish councillors and the Clerk.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and confirmed.

POND

This meeting had been called by Miss Knight, Chairman of P.C. to discuss the future of the pond. She told the parishioners present that the meeting had been called because some parents thought the pond should be filled in to prevent any further accidents. Recalling past history Miss Knight said that seven or eight years ago it was decided to keep the pond and a fund was raised to improve it. A petition had been presented to her signed by 94 persons expressing the hope that the pond would stay with us for years. It seemed to her illogical to fill it in as there were village ponds, some large, all over the country and it was impossible to remove every hazard from life.

Mr. Jackson said the pond was dirty and a source of danger to health. Miss Knight pointed out that it was for the parishioners to prevent the spoiling of the pond. by refuse.

Mrs. Watson suggested lining the pond for use as a paddling pool.

Mrs. Hamment suggested that members of the various societies in the village should be asked to keep it clean. Mr. Lush replied to the effect that this had already been done by the Horticultural Society.

Mr. Heary reminded the meeting that the pond did not belong to the village but to the Squire. Miss Knight agreed that representation would have to be made to him. further

Several/proposals were made including the introduction of an oil interceptor to cleanse the water coming from the main road, and that the pond should be made more shallow at the edges in the interests of safety. It was suggested that a sample of the water should be analysed.

During further discussion Miss Knight paid tribute to the co-operation received from the Godstone R.D.C. whose officers had said the pond could be filled in with rubble.

The following proposal was made by Mr. Lush and seconded by Mr. Cooke
