MINUTES OF THE PARISH MEETING HELD AT THE
CHURCH HALL on July 9th 1962.

A Parish meeting was held at the Church Hall on
July 9th 1962 at 8.30.p.m.

Present

Dr. R. Sturton in the chair with five Parish Councillors
with the Clerk and 50 Parishioners.

MATTERS ARISING

Dr Sturton opened the
meeting by asking the
parishioners if they
desired a village
hall. This was
passed nem con

The meeting was called to discuss the purchase of the
Church Hall. Dr. Sturton gave a brief history of the
hall. The Chairman said that it had been suggested
that the Parish Council should take over the hall as
the Church could not meet the cost of the estimated
expenditure. A profit of £59 was made in 1961, but this
would become a loss because of the elimination of two
items - income from the library and the lettings to the
Badminton club. Asked what would happen if the Council
refused to buy the hall Dr. Sturton replied "It ^{might} ~~would~~ be
knocked down and used for building". The Chairman
said that if the Council took over the hall he foresaw
a management committee, which would include represent-
atives of local bodies as well as the Council. With
repairs and the cost of additions he estimated a total
expenditure of between £5,000 and £6,000 and hoped that
a grant might be obtained of about a third of this. To
qualify for a grant 25% would have to be raised
voluntarily. Mr. Shaw commented "I think it is wrong
that people should have to pay twice for the building".
The Chairman said he thought the fault rested with the
^{Charity} ~~Church~~ Commissioners who had to decide the future of the
hall. The cost of renting the hall would be £180 per
annum on a lease. Present negotiations were on the basis
of the District Valuer's appraisal that the land was

worth about £2,500.0.0.

It was ~~unanimously~~ agreed on the need for a hall and by 27 votes to 14 the Council was authorised to levy a rate of up to ~~£1~~ in the pound (£) to pay for it. Mr. J. Howard urged repeatedly that aid should be sought from the Godstone R.D.C.. He felt a 20 year loan should be a district charge. The Chairman promised to investigate the possibilities, but was not optimistic. Mr. Mayes pleaded hardship on old folks if the rates went up. It was claimed by one member ^{kat} of the meeting was unrepresentative and wanted a referendum. The Chairman pointed out that this was impossible and Mr. Shaw pointed out that only 200 of the 900 electors bothered to vote at the last election. The Chairman said he hoped to call another meeting in October for a further discussion of the matter.

The meeting closed at 9.30.p.m.
